

Built in 1917 and inspired by ancient Spanish Colonial adobe churches, the New Mexico Museum of Art is regarded as an icon of Pueblo Revival style.


The New Mexico Museum of Art is on the Plaza in the heart of downtown Santa Fe.

St. Francis Auditorium

This venue remains the centerpiece of Santa Fe's cultural and social life. Great murals of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of Santa Fe, the historic McNary pipe organ, and wooden pews compliment this immense hall. St. Francis Auditorium is ideal for large and small weddings, concerts, lectures, recitals or meetings for up to 450.

Courtyard

This elegant, picturesque garden courtyard with spacious covered portals bedecked with murals and a fountain is perfect for celebrations for up to 70.

East and West Sculpture Gardens

Each area contains traditional and contemporary sculpture encircled by adobe walls, accommodating up to 300.

Women's Board Room

Original to the museum, this interior room, in the true style of northern New Mexico, accommodates up to 50.

Museum Lobby

The lobby, with authentic, hand-carved vigas and a latilla ceiling, can accommodate up to 200 for cocktail parties or sit-down dinners.



The Palace of the Governors is an enchanted location—indoors or out—for celebrating life’s precious moments: a retirement party, a 50th birthday, a 25th anniversary, or an intimate wedding. The tree-shaded courtyard offers a serene setting not only for applause and vows but also for cocktail receptions, concerts, lectures or luncheons. As the oldest continuously occupied public building in America, the Palace is as engaging as many of the events and exhibitions it effortlessly welcomes with unmatched charm and grace.

The venerated adobe structure, located in the heart of downtown Santa Fe, was designated a Registered National Historic Landmark in 1960 and an American Treasure in 1999.

Palace Lobby

The entrance to the Palace has old-world ambiance and can accommodate up to 75. Just outside is the Santa Fe Plaza, and under the portal is the Palace-sponsored Native American Artisans Program.

Courtyard

Hollyhocks and shade trees accentuate this unique venue, perfect for meetings and celebrations for up to 500, with or without a tent. The Palace Press is an accessible and enriching accent.

The Museum of Indian Arts & Culture and the Laboratory of Anthropology facilities offer spectacular venues for private parties, receptions and corporate events in a historic setting nestled along the foothills of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains.

Eight rental areas ranging from the intimacy of the Sculpture Garden to the spacious outdoor Performance Circle on Milner Plaza are available for small ceremonies to large, festive celebrations. The Lab, designed by southwest architect John Gaw Meem, opened in 1931 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

INDOOR SPACES

Meem Auditorium

Inside the Laboratory of Anthropology, the Pueblo Mission Style auditorium is adorned with tinwork, carved vigas and a lofty latilla ceiling; perfect for weddings, receptions, dinners and lectures. Capacity: 100 theater-style, 200 standing, or 60 seated with tables.

Lab Conference Room

Pueblo Revival architecture, furnishings from the WPA period and a large conference table saturate this historic room with warmth. Windows open onto the picturesque Milner Plaza. Accommodates A/V presentations. Capacity: 10.


The Kathryn O’Keeffe Theater

Located within the museum, this comfortable theater is perfect for lectures, panel discussions, film and audio presentations. Direct access to the Sculpture Garden. Capacity: 100.

Museum Lobby

The spacious lobby provides easy access to the O’Keeffe Theater and galleries and is ideal for small receptions before or after a theater event. Native American art is on display. Capacity: 100 standing.

OUTDOOR SPACES

Education Classroom

Located on the first floor of the museum, this large space is appropriate for small to medium-sized meetings. The classroom has running water and capabilities for media projection. Capacity: 70 standing, 60 seated, 50 with tables.

The Performance Circle, Sculpture Garden, and/or Ramada on Milner Plaza

Ideal for outdoor events with views of three mountain ranges and Santa Fe city lights. Large tents permitted. Capacity: 420 standing, 370 seated.

Ramada

An intimate space for small ceremonies with views of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains. Capacity: seating for 20 under the structure with an additional 20 seats outside.

Arnold and Doris Roland Sculpture Garden

Small gatherings can be held amid sculpture by Native American artists in a tranquil garden with desert plants adjacent to the museum. Capacity: 15 standing, 12 seated.

Housing the largest collection of international folk art in the world, this museum imparts an international flavor to any event. Set on Museum Hill,™ the spacious outdoor patios on Milner Plaza offer unparalleled views of the city and surrounding mountain ranges.

Atrium

Accommodates up to 200 in a spacious room with natural light for receptions, dinners, parties and celebrations.


Auditorium

Available for day or evening, the fully curtained, 15 x 30 ft. stage is a popular venue for meetings, seminars, lectures and performing arts with an audience capacity of 165.

Outdoor Classroom

This partially shaded, multi-purpose outdoor space holds up to 70. Popular for luncheons, workshops and classes.

Fountain and Overlook Patios



Intimate outdoor spaces offer mountain views in a relaxed atmosphere for 40 to 50.
